Course information

Portuguese online course is offered to the students.

Undergraduate students must choose this option during their online application;

Graduate students must inform their will by mail when sending the documents for application.

Language of courses

Portuguese (A2 desirable)

Grading System

Grades may range from zero to ten, and these numbers may be rounded to the nearest tenth (Rules and Regulations, article 83).

The student whose final grade is five or higher, and whose attendance is seventy percent or higher, shall earn the applicable credits (Rules and Regulations, article 84).

One 'In class' credit corresponds to 15 hours in a given semester, while one 'Workload' credit corresponds to 30 hours.

Exchange related information

Accomodation

The student can stay during one month in the Housing in a shared room (R\$ 15,00 per day), depending on availability.

Insurance

Health insurance with repatriation is mandatory.

Visa

VITEM IV (Student Visa) is required for each and every activity at FZEA/USP.
