Nomination and Application Procedures

Mandatory procedures for acceptance

Step 1/ Nomination (for undergraduate and graduate students)

- 1/ Passport
- 2/ Properly form (http://www.fzea.usp.br/en/?page_id=1856)
- 3/ Nomination letter or e-mail

The documents listed above must be sent by the Exchange Coordinator or the person in charge of the International Relations Office to the email intfzea@usp.br

Step 2/ Application

Undergraduate students: online (the applicant will receive a link to access Sistema Mundus after the nomination step)

Graduate students: by email (the applicant will receive extra information after the nomination step)

Deadlines for Nomination

1st semester (Feb – Jul) nomination deadline: October 15

2nd semester (Aug – Dec) nomination deadline: May 15

For undergraduate students. Graduate students can apply as they design an activity with a professor at FZEA.

Studying at FZEA/USP

Academic Calendar

1st semester: early February to middle July, depends on the academic year

2nd semester: early August to middle December, depends on the academic year

Course information

Portuguese online course is offered to the students.

Undergraduate students must choose this option during their online application;

Graduate students must inform their will by e-mail when sending the documents for application.

Language of courses

Portuguese (A2 desirable)

Grading System (undergraduate students)

Grades may range from zero to ten, and these numbers may be rounded to the nearest tenth (Rules and Regulations, article 83).

The student whose final grade is five or higher, and whose attendance is seventy percent or higher, shall earn the applicable credits (Rules and Regulations, article 84). One 'In class' credit corresponds to 15 hours in a given semester, while one 'Workload' credit corresponds to 30 hours.

Exchange related information

Accommodation

The student can stay during one month in the Housing in a shared room (R\$ 15,00 per day), depending on availability.

Insurance

Health insurance with repatriation is mandatory.

Visa

Student Visa is required for each and every activity at FZEA/USP. Brazilian Consular Representatives can indicate another type of Visa when appropriate.
